WHICH CLASS IS RIGHT FOR ME?

CERTIFIED CAD DRAFTER

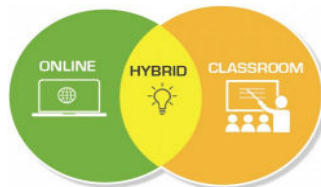
Certified CAD Drafter courses are designed for people who have no previous CAD or drafting experience. The program consists of two 80-hour courses that are currently offered online in the daytime and in the evenings. Students in this program learn basic drafting and AutoCAD skills, which prepare them for an entry-level drafting position. This program is project-based, which means that students not only learn AutoCAD, they also work on projects throughout each course. These projects are compiled into a portfolio that students can present to potential employers when interviewing for drafting positions.

- Upon completion of this program, students build an interdisciplinary portfolio of work they have completed in class. This portfolio includes: Mechanical, Architectural, Civil, Electronic and 3D drawings in the latest release of AutoCAD.

- Credits earned in the program can be converted to college credit; specifically, DFTG 1009 converts to DFTG 1405, and DFTG 2019 converts to DFTG 2419.

- This certificate program is a part of ACC's "Fast Track" program, which provides a **50% discount on the tuition**.

- The Certified CAD Drafter program is now being offered in a **Hyflex** format. This means instruction is offered on-campus, with students having the flexibility to attend in person or virtually on any given class day. □

SELF-PACED ONLINE

Our **Complete Guide online** classes are self-guided online course designed to give students a solid understanding of software features and capabilities. Since this course does not teach drafting concepts or standards, it is a great course for students who already have a drafting background and/or experience in their field of specialization, who just need to learn how to use the software as a drafting tool. These courses have a mix of learning modules: videos, reading and hands-on exercises, combining different learning styles. There are no projects to complete in this course; once one exercise module is completed, the next one becomes available. Students have 60 days to complete this course, but will have access to the learning modules for an entire year.
